See, Think, Wonder

Part 1: Use the photo below to prompt discussion. Display the image from the digital archive for students to see and ask them (they can record their thoughts on the worksheet provided):

- 1. What **do you see** in the picture (have them write, or say, everything they see)
- 2. What **do you think about** what you see? (time period, location)
- 3. What does this make you wonder about?

You can prompt students to look at the different types of buildings, what material is the building made of? What might the buildings be used for? Do the buildings look the same today or different? Do you recognize where this is? Direct them to consider the size/width of the street - what type of transportation is being used? How is this similar or different from what we see today?

Part 2: Then have students use <u>Google Street View</u> to look at what this area looks like today. They could use the toggle tool to move around and examine the 'current' view. Students can then compare then vs. now. What is the same? What is different? What would make these changes? You could record your class observations in a venn diagram.
